BURWOOD BEACH WWTW

HUNTER WATER IS UPGRADING THE LOCAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM TO IMPROVE OUR WATERWAYS AND THE ENVIRONMENT SURROUNDING BURWOOD BEACH.

THIS FACT SHEET PROVIDES AN UPDATE ABOUT THIS KEY PROJECT AND HOW WE ARE MANAGING THE LOCAL ENVIRONMENT ALONG WITH THE CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS.

Burwood Beach Wastewater Treatment Works (WWTW) is undergoing an upgrade to ensure it continues to operate reliably and sustainably in the future.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES THURSDAY 10TH DECEMBER 2009

Construction commenced on the Burwood Beach WWTW Stage 2 Upgrade in September 2009 and work has progressed rapidly for the third aeration tank and the fourth clarifier.

On 10th December 2009 the flooring of the aeration tank will be installed. This requires the pouring of concrete in one continuous period to attain a complete floor installation and to achieve the best quality performance from the concrete product. Structural and sealing performance qualities of the concrete are critical to successful construction outcomes.

To achieve a continuous concrete pour the construction

team will work between the hours of 6am to 8.30pm on the 10th December 2009.

COMMUNITY & ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS

There will be 4 to 6 concrete truck deliveries every hour throughout the day. Deliveries are expected to stop before 6pm.

Work will continue until early evening to "finish" the concrete to achieve the required surface and levels. This may require some lighting which will be directed onto the work area and away from residences.

The access road to Burwood Beach WWTW remains closed to public access for safety of our workers and the community.
