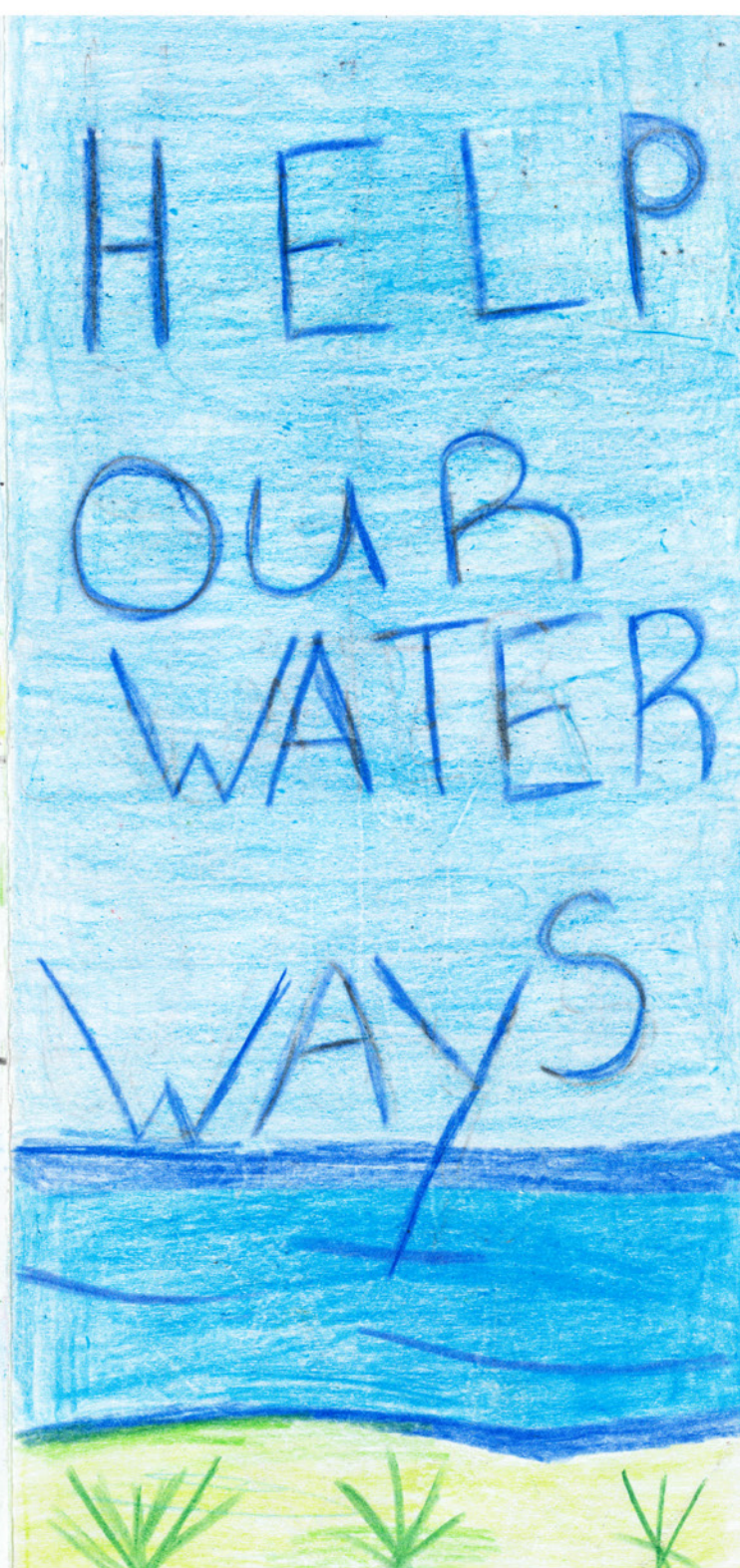

# Things That you can do to help the water ways

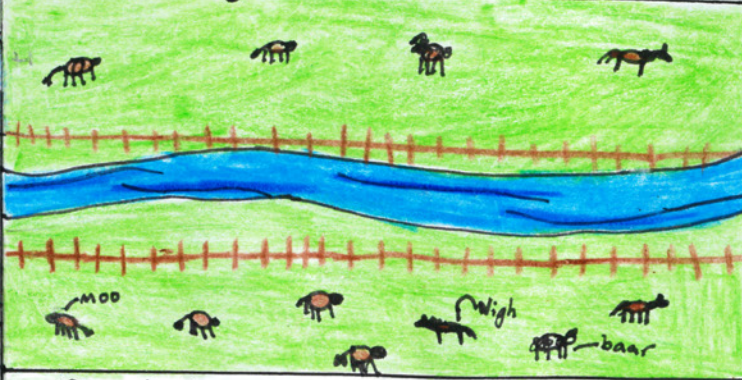
1. pick up all your rubbish and if you see any rubbish pick it up too!

- The rubbish that goes down the drain ends up in the ocean killing animals in there

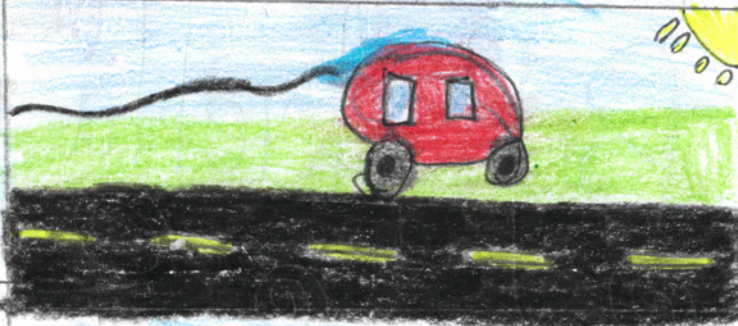


- Soapy water from car washing also goes down the storm drain which is not good for the sea!! And the fish in it!!

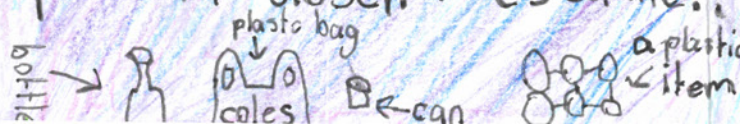


- Try to atleast pick up 3 pieces of rubbish when you go out somewhere

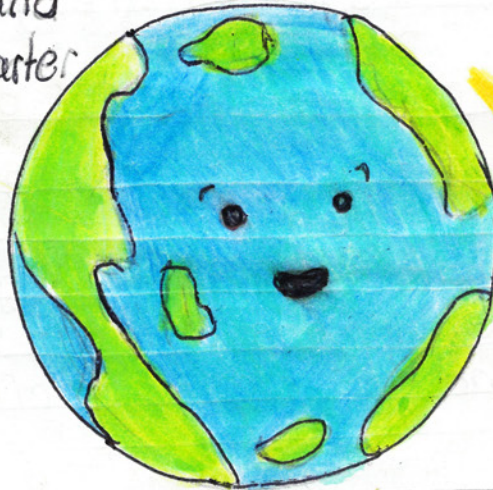

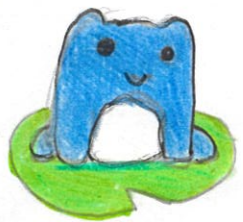

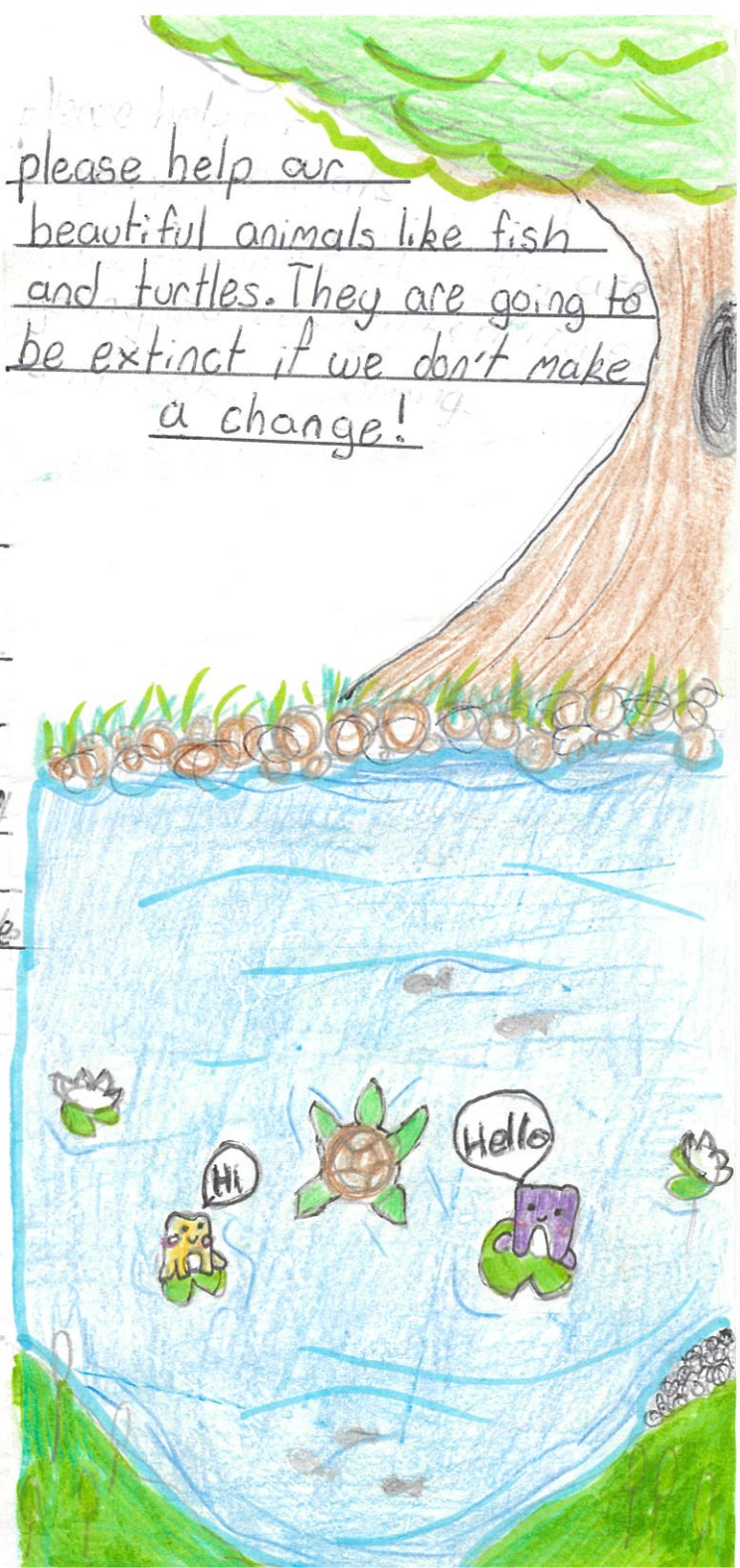
By 4040 no one will know

# 6 Ways to help our water ways.
