Work in your area – Munibung Creek Rehabilitation

We wrote to you in October 2024 to let you know that work to rehabilitate the southern section of Munibung Creek – between Pendlebury Road and 75 Lachlan Road, Cardiff – will start soon. We've engaged NSW Soil Conservation Service to complete this work on our behalf.

About the work

Soil Conservation Service will be carrying out some **minor early work from Monday 9 December 2024**, ahead of main works to rehabilitate Munibung Creek starting from early January 2025.

Early work includes:

- Removal of overgrown vegetation along the open drain on the Council owned land between 87-89 Lachlan Road.
- Installation of stormwater pipe and a concrete stormwater pit on the Council owned land between 87-89 Lachlan Road. The existing drain will be backfilled once the pipework has been installed.
- Weed management along the Munibung Creek channel, weather permitting.

Our work schedule

The early work is expected to start from **Monday 9 December 2024** and will take place over about 3-4 days between Monday 9 December and Friday 20 December, assuming the weather is fine and there are no major issues.

Most activity will be carried out between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm, weather permitting. If we need to work outside these times, we will let you know.

How will this affect you?

You may notice additional noise, changes to local traffic movements and construction vehicles (including excavators and tipper trucks) in Lachlan and John Streets while early work is completed.

Our aim is to minimise inconvenience to you, and we thank you for your patience during this work.
