

Platt Street Stormwater Project

Hunter Water is rehabilitating the stormwater network in Waratah, which involves relining over 250 metres of a stormwater culvert. Work is being done by our contractor, Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure.


Project extension

We are continuing work on Platt Street however due to some difficult and unexpected service relocations, along with complex ground conditions, the project is now expected to be completed by **the end of April 2025**. Local bus routes are not affected and are operating normally.

Platt Street is **partially open** to general traffic with new traffic control measures in place to enhance safety and guide motorists through this area of works. Access to properties will be maintained and traffic controllers will be onsite intermittently to assist.

The site compound located on Platt Street will remain on site until **May 2025** as it is being used by Abergeldie for another Hunter Water project close by. This will not affect the completion or restoration of work areas on Platt Street, and once the site compound is removed the site will be restored to its original state.

How will this affect you?

During these works, you will notice:

- reduced speed limits to 40km/h
- construction traffic signs and traffic controls in place
- construction workers, trucks, equipment and vehicles in the area.

Extension of shared path closure

Due to the site challenges mentioned previously, the current closure of the shared footpath on Platt Street is also expected to extend to **late-April 2025**.

Map of shared path closure




Upcoming work

As part of the project, we will also be completing some additional work in the area:

- **Roundabout works** the reinstatement of the roundabout at the intersection of Platt Street, Prince Street and Turton Road will start in the coming weeks.
- **Road reinstatement works** we will soon be reinstating the road on Platt Street which involves milling the existing surface and installing a new layer of asphalt.
