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Work in your area – Murray Street update

We previously wrote to you about the construction of a new water main in your area, that will distribute treated water to the network from the Belmont Desalination Plant once it is complete.

Upcoming underboring works

Before we begin the final sections of water main installation along Ntaba Road and Murray Street, our team will complete an underbore opposite to **15 and 17 Murray Street, Jewells**. This method will allow us to safely install the new water main beneath an existing stormwater service while keeping it operational.

These works are scheduled to start on **Thursday 25 June 2026** and are expected to take approximately two weeks to complete, assuming the weather is fine and there are no major issues.

During this time the following traffic arrangements will be in place:

- A single lane closure around the work area.
- Traffic controllers onsite to assist motorists and pedestrians during daytime working hours (7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday) with temporary traffic lights in use outside of these hours.

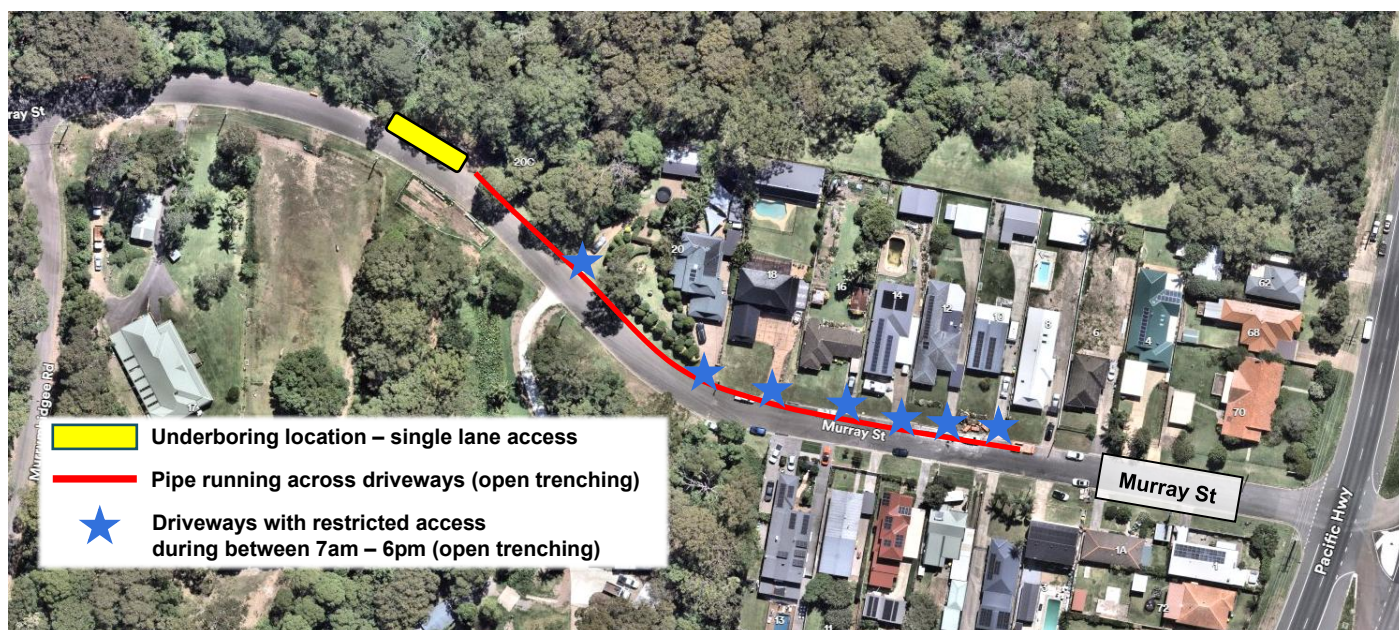
Driveway access will be maintained, and there aren't any planned interruptions to existing services.

Open trenching

Open trenching works in Murray Street were previously postponed due to our construction crews focusing on priority works near the Belmont Desalination Plant.

Following completion of the underboring works, we expect to begin open trenching in Murray Street to install the new water main. While the exact timing will depend on progress of other priority works, we'll aim to have this work completed as quickly as possible and will provide residents with an update and more information well before this work starts.

When our open trenching work resumes, there will be some **temporary traffic changes**, including the removal of street parking, restrictions to driveways and single-lane closures to keep everyone safe.
