Hello from Hunter Water

Changed Pedestrian and Traffic Conditions – Platt Street

Hunter Water is rehabilitating our stormwater network in Waratah, which involves relining over 250 metres of a stormwater culvert located near you – along Platt Street, Waratah. We have engaged a contractor, Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure (Abergeldie), to carry out the work on our behalf.

Shared path closure

The shared path located above the culvert between Prince Street and Waratah Station will be temporarily closed from **Monday 18 November 2024 for up to 10 weeks**, weather permitting. This closure helps us to keep our community safe while we are installing the liner. We've included a map below showing the location of the closure area.

The closure will be during the normal work hours of **7am until 6pm Monday to Friday and Saturday from 8am to 1pm**. Outside of these times the path will be returned to public access. Abergeldie will also temporarily re-open the path over the festive period shutdown.

How will this affect you?

A pedestrian and cycle detour will be in place during construction hours during this period. Traffic control and signage will be on Platt Street for shared path users. Some parking on Platt Street may also be restricted during this work.
