The owner must install at their own cost a site containment backflow prevention device that meets the hazard rating for the use and type of property. The location of the device shall be located at the property boundary at the outlet of the water meter on domestic services and after the inlet valve on all fire services. The device must be installed and maintained in accordance with the requirements of AS/NZS 3500 and AS/NZS 2845.	
18	Special Conditions	Ensure the Grease Traps are serviced by a licensed liquid wastewater contractor at intervals not exceeding 12 weeks or more frequently if advised by the contractor. Cleanout documentation is to be kept on site for future inspections. (a). For the purpose of avoiding unintended discharges to the Sewer or the stormwater drainage system, all matter and substances on the Premises must be processed, handled, moved and stored in a proper and efficient manner. (b). Any substance on the Premises which, if discharged to the Sewer, may pose a danger to the environment, the Sewer or workers at a waste water treatment plant or may harm any sewage treatment process must be handled, moved and stored in areas where leaks, spillages or overflows cannot drain by gravity or by automated or other mechanical means to the Sewer or the stormwater drainage system.
